Line up starts at 9:30 a.m., beside the Cavalier Green, on W. State St. Entries must be in place by 10:30 a.m. to be eligible for awards. The parade starts at 11:00 a.m. Queens must provide their own transportation. Equestrian/Animal units must provide their own clean up crews. Color Guard Units will be limited to the Color Guard Members only- Other entries by the organization must be filed on a separate application and will be split into a separate parade unit.

# JULY 4<sup>th</sup> Celebration



Get ready for the Corunna 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade because we want you to be a part of it!

The parade will start at 11 a.m. at the corner of N. Shiawassee St. and W. State St., in downtown Corunna, next to the Shiawassee Street School. Check-in is at the corner of N. Shiawassee and W. State or S. Norton and W. State. At check-in, you will be directed to your space location. Line-up starts at 9:30 a.m. You must have your entry in place by 10:30 a.m. to be eligible for an award.

The theme for this year is "Born In America" but you are welcome to decorate your entry any way you wish. Loud music is encouraged. There will be six trophies given for the "Best Decorated", "Best Theme", "Best Youth Group", "Best Rookie", "Most Patriotic" and a grand prize trophy "Best in Show" given out before the start of the parade.

The parade will head north down N. Shiawassee and turn left onto W. Mack St. At the end of W. Mack St. the parade will turn left and head south on Norton St. It will cross W. Corunna Ave. and continue on to W. State St. The parade will then continue back to the start of the parade where you will disband. No one is allowed to leave the parade route until you reach W. State St. At that corner, you may either turn left to continue back to your lineup spot or go straight.

There are no weapons, fireworks, or alcohol allowed in the parade line up area or during the parade. Please make sure that all children riding on vehicles are safe from falling off. Candy cannot be thrown from a vehicle. You can hand candy to kids or it can be thrown on the ground in front of them. Political or campaign material is not allowed to be passed out by parade participants.

Please be sure to include a brief narration describing your parade entry, business, or upcoming event to be read during the parade.
